Provider	Prepaid	Postpaid
Telstra	YES – a range of prepaid plans with data rollover and auto-recharge options & casual plans for infrequent users	YES – month-to-month and handset-bundled contracts (SIM-only & device-inclusive)
Optus	YES – Pay as you go options for flexible recharges	YES – multiple postpaid plans including “Choice Plus” SIM-only with 5G, no excess data charges, and perks like subscription credits. Device contract plans too
Vodafone	YES – “Prepaid Plus” lineup; flexible 28-day recharge, data rollover, uncapped slow speeds after data use	YES – contract-free SIM-only postpaid plans with tiered data allowances and 5G
TPG	YES – SIM-only plans (Small 25 GB, Medium 50 GB, Large 100 GB) with a prepaid recharge model	NO – only prepaid SIM-only mobile plans
Amaysim	YES – prepaid SIM plans (7-day, 28-day, 365-day) with data rollover and roaming packs	NO – only prepaid plans
ALDI Mobile	YES – exclusively prepaid plans (30-day, 365-day, Pay-As-You-Go)	NO – no postpaid offerings
Belong	NO – only postpaid SIM-only plans	YES – SIM-only plans with data banking/sharing

Aussie Broadband	NO – no prepaid plans	YES – postpaid SIM-only plans (20 GB to 220 GB+) on Optus network.
Dodo Services	NO – no prepaid plans	YES – postpaid SIM-only plans on Optus network
Boost Mobile	YES – prepaid SIM plans only (7-day, 28-day, long-expiry packs)	NO – no postpaid plans
Felix Mobile	NO – no prepaid plans	YES – single month-to-month subscription (Vodafone network)
Kogan Mobile	YES – prepaid SIM plans (30-day, 90-day, 365-day recharge packs)	NO – no postpaid plans
Moose Mobile	NO – no prepaid plans	YES – month-to-month SIM-only plans (Optus network)
Spintel	NO – no prepaid plans	YES – month-to-month SIM-only plans (Optus network)
Everyday Mobile	YES – prepaid options with auto-recharge or manual top-up	YES – month-to-month postpaid plans
Southern Phone	NO – no prepaid plans	YES – month-to-month SIM-only plans (Optus network)

Exetel	YES – All Exetel mobile plans are 30-day, prepaid services which mimics postpaid but requires upfront payment	NO – they do not offer postpaid options
iPrimus	NO – no prepaid plans	YES – month-to-month SIM-only plans (Optus network)
Lebara Mobile	YES – flexible 30-day recharge packs, international call inclusions, data rollover	NO – no postpaid plans
Macquarie Telecom	NO – consumer prepaid plans	YES – business-grade postpaid plans (Telstra network)
Superloop	YES – All superloop mobile plans have a 30-day billing cycle with data banking	NO - While they do not offer traditional postpaid plans (where you pay after usage), they do allow for auto-recharge
